

**Statement on Safety**  
**MEDARVA Surgery Centers**

Your doctor has chosen to perform your surgery or procedure at MEDARVA Stony Point Surgery Center. We want to ensure you that in this uncertain time, as always, **our facility is safe, sterile, and an appropriate setting for your care.**

MEDARVA Stony Point Surgery Center and its sister facility, West Creek Surgery Center, are well-known for their infection rates, which are the lowest in the region. In recent months, Duke University reviewed over 1,000 surgeries performed in our facilities, finding zero cases of infection and awarding us the highest patient care rating of **Excellent**. We have maintained this trend over a four-year span.

Furthermore, patients experienced surgical site infections in only 0.014% of cases at MEDARVA Stony Point and West Creek Surgery Centers in 2019, making us **the safest and best option for your outpatient operation**. At Stony Point, surgery is all we do, which allows to maintain a high level of sanitation and safety each and every day. Even during these unprecedented times, Stony Point has maintained this level of extreme safety through measures geared towards sanitation and social distancing.

Below are some of the measures taken by MEDARVA Stony Point Surgery Center to ensure your safety and that of our staff and surgeons:

- Limiting access to the building to ensure a safe distance can be maintained between individuals
  - Only one visitor is allowed per patient, others will be asked to wait in their car
  - For pediatric patients, only parents are allowed
- Every individual entering the building is being screened by a team of clinical staff
  - This includes all staff and physicians being monitored **daily**
  - Triaging for any symptoms by our nursing staff
- No patients of our adjoining Medical Office Building are being permitted access to the Surgery Center
- Increased availability of hand sanitizer and mask stations, which have been placed throughout the building and at every entrance for patients and visitors to use as they enter
- Clinical and Materials Teams have worked diligently to ensure a sufficient supply of cleaning and sanitizing materials and personal protective equipment (PPE)

Again, we are here to serve you, the patient. **Your safety is our utmost concern.** We are taking universal precautions to ensure that your operation is a safe and comfortable experience. Universal precaution means that we are utilizing the strictest and most thorough of measures for every patient - regardless.
